

Requirements to structure of the Article

Article should comply with the following document structure:

- Title of the article;
- Information about the authors;
- Abstract;
- Key words;
- Introduction;
- The body of article;
- Conclusion;
- References.

More detailed information with requirements to information about authors, abstract, key words, the body of article and references is presented below.

Information about the authors

Information about the authors includes the following information:

- name and surname of each author;
- academic degree and/or job title;
- name of the scientific or educational institution or organization with its full address where the scientific study was done or where the authors work;
- e-mail (published in the footer of the first page only with the author's permission).

The article could be submitted by one of its authors, who is granted the permission of all other co-authors (if present).

Abstract

Abstract should describe the most important aspects of the article. Abstract gives a general overview of the paper. Recommended volume of abstract is 100-150 words.

Key words

Key words should describe the main theme of article. Recommended volume of key words is 5-7 words.

The body of article

Principally the article should include three main parts:

- Introduction;
- The body text;
- Conclusion.

References

References are placed at the end of the article. Bibliography is based on the order of references in the text. In the text references are given in square brackets.
